**Farm 3 Phase Service**

**AVAILABILITY**

Available to customers outside corporate limits located on or near District's three-phase lines for all farm, home, schools, churches, public buildings, non-irrigation pumps, equipment, commercial and residential uses subject to its established rules and regulations.

**TYPE OF SERVICE**

Three-phase, 60 cycle, at available voltages.

**RATE:**

**SUMMER -** for energy (kWh's) used during the months of June-July-August-September

Monthly Customer Charge	\$ 37.25
All kWh's Distribution capacity charge	1.4 ¢ per kWh
All kWh's Wholesale power costs	6.9 ¢ per kWh
Total per kWh	8.3 ¢

**WINTER -** for energy (kWh's) used during the months of  
January-February-March-April-May-October-November-December

Monthly Customer Charge	\$ 37.25
All kWh's Distribution capacity charge	1.4 ¢ per kWh
All kWh's Wholesale power costs	4.8 ¢ per kWh
Total per kWh	6.2 ¢

**MINIMUM CHARGES**

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be the Customer Charge of \$37.25 where 10 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For consumers requiring more than 10 KVA of transformer capacity, the minimum monthly charge shall be increased at the rate of 90¢ for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required.

**ANNUAL CHARGES FOR SEASONAL SERVICES**

Customers requiring service for less than 500 kWh, per year may request service according to Annual Three Phase with an annual minimum charge is due and payable in advance under the Annual Three Phase Rate. Any service disconnected and reconnected at the customer's request within a twelve month period by the customer will be charged a disconnect or reconnect fee for each trip to render service. The district stand-by service rider applies to this rate.

**TERMS OF PAYMENT**

The above rates are net. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid by the due date shown on the bill, then delinquent charges shall be added according to District Collection Policies.
