General Service

AVAILABILITY

Service under this schedule is for non-seasonal, non-residential and non-farm service, including but not limited to commercial establishments, separate garages and out-buildings only and other loads which are not classified for service under other rate schedules. Service is subject to the District's established rules and regulations and limited to 150 kva of transformer capacity.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Single-phase, 60 cycle, at available voltages.

Three-phase, 60 cycle, at available voltages.

RATE:

SUMMER - for energy (kWh's) used during the months of June-July-August-September

Monthly Customer Charge	\$20.15
All kWh's Distribution capacity charge	1.8 ¢ per kWh
All kWh's Wholesale power costs	7.7 ¢ per kWh
Total per kWh	9.5 ¢

WINTER - for energy (kWh's) used during the months of
January-February-March-April-May-October November-December

Monthly Customer Charge	\$20.15
All kWh's Distribution capacity charge	1.8 ¢ per kWh
All kWh's Wholesale power costs	5.4 ¢ per kWh
Total per kWh	7.2 ¢

Three phase Customer Charge \$31.80 per month

MINIMUM CHARGES

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be the Customer Charge where 10 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For consumers requiring more than 10 KVA of transformer capacity, the minimum monthly charge shall be increased at the rate of 90¢ for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required.

ANNUAL CHARGES FOR SEASONAL SERVICES

Customers requiring service less than 500 kwh per year may request service according to Annual Single Phase or Annual Three Phase for an annual minimum charge is due and payable in advance under Annual Single Phase or Annual Three Phase. Any service disconnected and reconnected at the customer's request within a twelve month period by the customer will be charged a disconnect or reconnect fee for each trip to render service. The district stand-by service rider applies to this rate.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

The above rates are net. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid by the date stated on the bill, then delinquent charges shall be added according to District Collection Policies.
