Residential Time of Use Rates

AVAILABILITY

Available to members of the District that are residential For residential uses subject to NeNPPD established rules and regulations.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Single-phase, 60 cycle, at available voltages.

RATE:

ON-PEAK Hours: 7:00 am to 10:00 am and 4:00 pm – 10:00 pm daily except Sundays and in addition January 1, July 4, and December 25 are considered off peak days.

OFF-PEAK Hours: All other hours not identified as being On-Peak.

SUMMER - for energy (kWh's) used during the months of June-July-August-September

Monthly Customer Charge		\$21.35
All kWh's	Distribution capacity charge	1.4 ¢ per kWh
On Peak	Wholesale power costs	8.3 ¢ per kWh
Off Peak	Wholesale power costs	3.0 ¢ per kWh

WINTER - for energy (kWh's) used during the months of
January-February-March-April-May-October-November-December

Monthly Customer Charge		\$21.35
All kWh's	Distribution capacity charge	1.4 ¢ per kWh
On Peak	Wholesale power costs	8.3 ¢ per kWh
Off Peak	Wholesale power costs	2.4 ¢

MINIMUM CHARGES

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be the Customer Charge of \$21.35 where 10 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For consumers requiring more than 10 KVA of transformer capacity, the minimum monthly charge shall be increased at the rate of 90¢ for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required when this can be determined.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

The above rates are net. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid by the date stated on the bill, then delinquent charges shall be added according to District Collection Policies.
